## **TKT Modules 1, 2 and 3**

Teaching Knowledge Test - The Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT) is a test from Cambridge ESOL about teaching English to speakers of other languages. It aims to increase teachers' confidence and enhance job prospects by focusing on the core teaching knowledge needed by teachers of primary, secondary or adult learners, anywhere in the world.

## **TKT Practical**

This is a new TKT module which gives teachers certification for their practical teaching abilities. It complements the range of teaching tests and awards offered by Cambridge ESOL and can be taken together with other TKT modules or on its own

## **TKT CLIL – Content Language Integrated Learning**

It tests a candidate's knowledge of Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL) and the practice of planning, teaching and assessing curriculum subjects taught in English.

## **TKT Young Learners**

It tests a candidate's knowledge of theory and methodology on teaching young learners.

## **TKT KAL – Knowledge About Language**

It tests a candidate's knowledge of the language systems needed by teachers for planning and teaching their lessons. It tests knowledge of how the different features of English work from a teaching perspective.

## **B1 PET Preparation Course for *English Teachers* (20 hours AISLi accredited)**

This is a course aimed at providing course participants with exam preparation and techniques for the PET Exam.

## **Teaching English to Children with Learning Difficulties (3 hours AISLi accredited)**

This is a 3-hour workshop aimed at providing course participants with an overview of what Learning Disabilities are and the strategies which can be used to help children we may come in contact with in our classrooms.

## **Let's Play English (8 hours AISLi accredited)**
